To support parents with the transition from Google Classroom to Microsoft Teams, we are pleased to invite you to an introductory training session designed to familiarise parents with the Microsoft Teams system. This session will provide an overview of how to navigate the platform, access learning resources, and support your child's learning at home. Parents of students currently in Preschool – Year 5 are invited in on **Monday 23rd June** at either **7:45 am – 9:00 am** or **2:45 pm – 3:45 pm**. Provision will be provided for students until the end of the session. More information will follow.

Year 5 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 23rd June

Maths	In maths, the children will be recapping their learning of equivalent fractions, converting improper fractions to mixed numbers, then mixed numbers to improper fractions and adding and subtracting fractions.
English	As the children continue their learning of poetry, they will be learning about nonfiction poetry, then will collaborate to write a poem about nature. After, they will explore poetry through music.
Science	In science the children will be recapping everything they have learn this half term, including different types of seed dispersal.
Integrated Curriculum	In topic, the children will be conducting their own research about Antarctica. Then, they will be learning about how the animals adapt to living there.

Reading for Pleasure

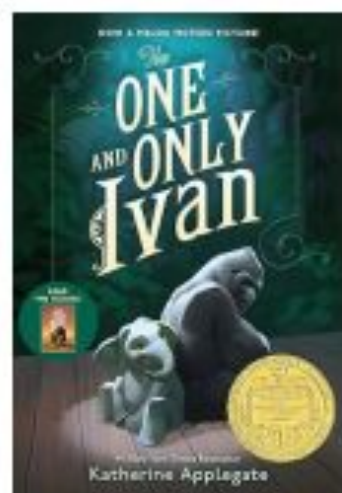

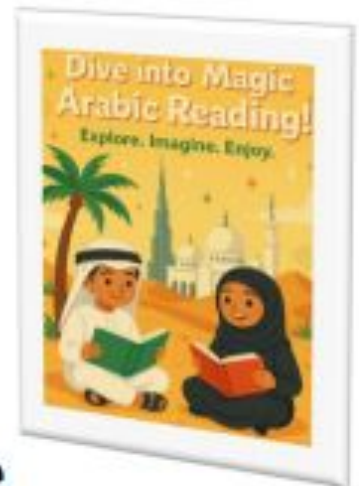
