## Year 1 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 30th June

In maths we will revisit our learning about addition and subtraction. We will revise various methods to add and subtract and practise these to complete different sums. We will ensure that when adding 2 numbers our answer is greater and when subtracting our answer is less than the number that we started with.

During our English lessons, we will revise our learning about sentence structure and writing sentences. We will write sentences reflecting on our school year and also our hopes for the summer. We will ensure that our writing include full sentences with capital letters and punctuation such as full stops, exclamation marks and question marks.

In our Phonic lessons we will revisit our learning for the sounds 'ear' (as in bear), 'are' (as in care), 'y' (as in very) and 'ph' (as in photo). We will use our knowledge to read and spell words containing these sounds as well as forming them correctly. We will practise reading real words and pseudo alien words.

For science, we will be visiting the grow zone to observe worms. We will listen to Ms Catrin and found out what the worms eat, how they grow and how to look after them. We will then make our own worm in class.


Reading for pleasure can help to improve student achievement in school. Research has shown that students who read at home do 'significantly better' across the curriculum than students who don't read.


To support our students with their reading choices, we would like to recommend some great books and authors each half term.


Reading regularly in Arabic doesn't just help you get better at the language; it helps you shine in all your subjects too!
