Year 4 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 30th June

Maths	In Maths, the children will be consolidating their understanding and learning from the year. They will be working through puzzles and codebreakers, using multiple mathematical skills.
English	In English, the children will be recapping skills and writing styles from throughout the year. They will be developing their narrative writing as well as covering the structure of a playscript.
Science	In Science, the children will be using their knowledge and understanding to complete scientific experiments. They will be making predictions and then fulfilling their investigation to see if their hypothesis was correct, also whilst maintaining a fair test.
Integrated Curriculum	In Topic, the children will be participating in their own Victorian Tea Party! A morning filled with fun and facts, the children will celebrate their learning.

Reading for Pleasure

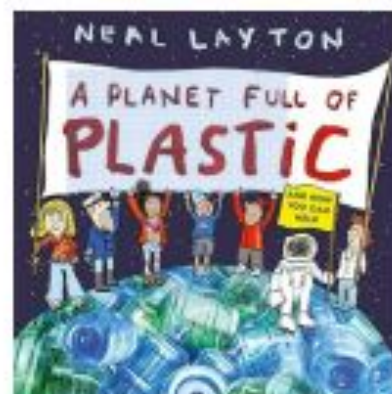
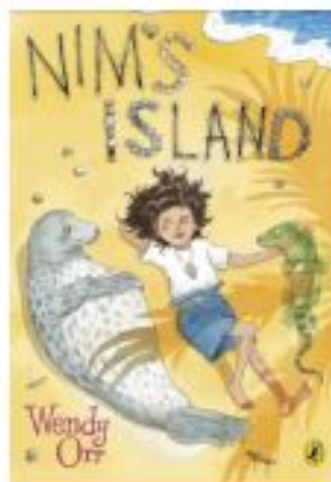
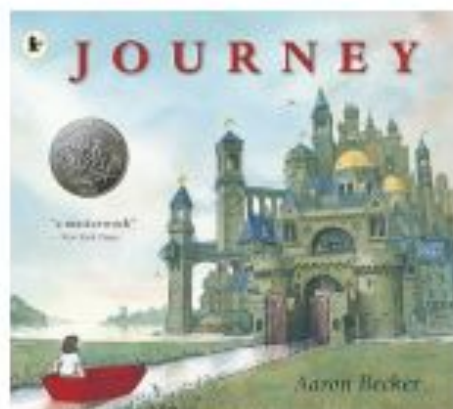
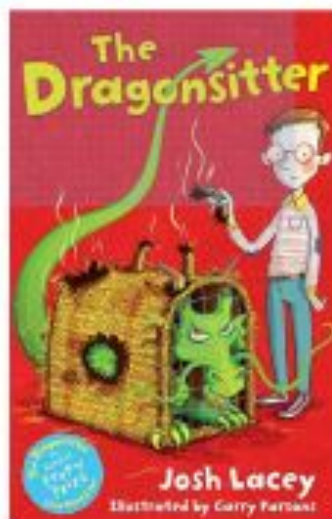

Did you know that reading in Arabic can take you on amazing adventures, introduce you to unforgettable characters, and help you fall in love with the language?

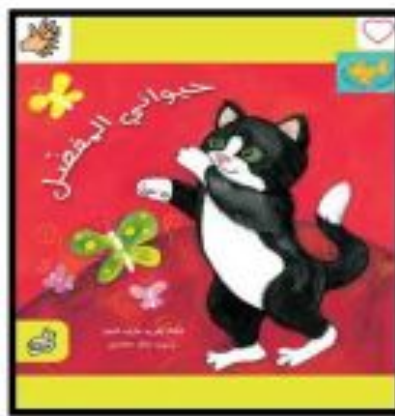
