Preschool learning:

Week beginning: Monday 21st April

This week in math, we will explore the environment to find sets of items that we can use to create our own ABAB patterns. We will identify and correct any errors in our patterns and learn how to create more complex patterns, such as AAB, ABC, and ABCD, using the items we have found.

This week in Literacy, we will explore "Jack and the Beanstalk" using engaging props such as soft toys, puppets, and simple cutouts to act out the story. We will encourage each other to participate by joining in on key phrases such as "Fee-fi-fo-fum!" and "I'll climb the beanstalk!". We will also attempt to use our big and small voices to represent the giant and Jack, enhancing our phonics skills and expression.

In our drawing club this week, we will explore the rhyming story "The Rhyming Dust Bunnies," introducing key vocabulary words along with their meanings and corresponding actions. We will consistently revisit these three words and actions throughout the week to reinforce learning, ensuring that by the end, we can say the words while performing the actions. Our goal is to make language fun and engaging through interactive games and activities, while also sharing the vocabulary on our word wall to encourage play and exploration of language.

This week in Understanding the World, we will be engaging the children in a range of hands-on activities focused on the concept of pulling. They will have the opportunity to explore this idea through various interactive experiences. We are excited to see their curiosity and learning in action!

This week in Expressive Art and Design, we will be engaging with each other in a fun activity called "pitch matching" using the song "Incy Wincy Spider." We will start by singing the song together, demonstrating different pitches and incorporating hand motions to illustrate the spider's movements. We will have the opportunity to take turns singing, experimenting with various pitches, and even creating our versions of the song, all while we celebrate their efforts and progress!

Preschool PE Days:

PE will be on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. On their PE days, students should wear their PE kit to school.
