Year 1 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 21st April 2025

This term, in English, we will be looking at poetry based on the story 'Shark in the Park'. We will start our learning by talking the text and agree on actions to perform when telling the story. We will then rehearse the retelling of the story using our actions. We will then identify the different rhyming words from the text and order the events in the story.

In maths, we will continue our topic on measurement. We will begin the week investigating capacity and learning the vocabulary related to this topic such as full, empty, half full, half empty. We will then use objects to be able to record measurement and compare the capacity of various containers. We will end the week by recapping our learning on counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. We will use this knowledge to support our learning of recognising equal groups (repeated addition)

During our Phonic lessons we will be revising the digraphs 'ea' (as in head), 'er' (as in her) and 'ir' (as in bird). We will use our knowledge to read and spell words containing these sounds as well as forming them correctly.

In Science we will continue to work scientifically and revisit our learning from this week about materials that sink and float. We will then make our own boat using the materials that we think is the best to float. Finally we will test our designs. In Art we will continue learning about primary and secondary colours and understand that you can mix primary colours to make secondary ones.




