## Preschool learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 28th April

This week in math, we will first discuss how we have learned to create both simple and complex patterns. Now we will take on the role of the Pattern Police. Our important task is to identify mistakes in repeating patterns. We will also present the "Spot My Mistake" PowerPoint game to help each other in this exciting mission!

This week in Drawing Club, we'll read the rhyming story "Llama Llama Goes to School." Afterward, we'll select three vocabulary words with actions to use throughout the week. Finally, we will draw a character from the story while sharing ideas and expanding our sentences and vocabulary.

This week in Understanding the World, we will explore the force of gravity through engaging, hands-on activities. Working together we will observe how different objects fall and learn that gravity is a force that pulls everything toward the Earth. Through these experiments, they will develop a deeper understanding of the world around them.

This week in Expressive Art and Design, we will explore various materials to inspire creativity and expression of thoughts and feelings. We will also begin developing complex stories using small world equipment while discussing safety when traveling in vehicles. We will learn about the importance of wearing seat belts through a fun role-play activity, where we will take on roles as passengers and a driver in a "car" made from chairs. To support us with this important learning experience, you are welcome to send us a photo of you child using their seatbelt to share with their friends and teachers.

This week in Literacy, we will explore our model text for "Jack and the Beanstalk." Having learned key vocabulary from the story, we will focus on identifying those words within the model text. This activity will help reinforce their understanding and enhance their reading skills.

This week in Phonics, we will advance to Aspect 7, focusing on oral blending and segmenting. Additionally, we will continue exploring rhyming words through stories and interactive activities in discovery time.

Things to remember: We will be building small worlds again but this time with more complexity. Please can you send to school any clean empty boxes, egg cartons, plastic bottles, pots, containers etc that you no longer need, to support our creations.
