Year 1 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 28th April

In maths we will be continuing our topic of multiplication and division. We will start the week by doubling numbers using pictures and practical items to aid. We will then use this knowledge to complete doubling sums. Then we will make equal groups by grouping and sharing objects to solve our sums.

During our English lessons, we will continue to learn the text 'Shark in the Park'. We will look at the beginning, middle and end of the text and 'box up' some of our own ideas to make changes to the text. Then we will use our 'boxing up' ideas to write our own version of the text.

In our Phonic lessons we will be revising the digraphs 'ur' (as in fur), 'oo' (as in look) and 'oo' (as in pool). We will use our knowledge to read and spell words containing these sounds as well as forming them correctly. We will also practise reading real words and pseudo alien words.

For science, we will 'work scientifically' by conducting the Dancing Raisins Investigation. We will continue to ask questions and explore different ways they can be answered.

During our topic work we will revise our knowledge of the 7 Emirates and some facts about these. As well as identify the Sheikh for each Emirate
