Week beginning: Monday 5th May

Maths	Next week, the children will start their learning on angles. They will learn to classify angles, measure angles up to 180 degrees and draw lines and angles.
English	Next week, the children will be creating their own text map using ideas from our model text. Then, they will be learning to innovate our model text by looking at the structure and using cohesion through devices.
Science	In science, the children will be learning about the human life cycle and then will be learning to identify the key stages that have happened in their life so far.
Integrated Curriculum	In topic, the children will be recording information about The Great Wall of China before learning about trade in the Far East.

Respect



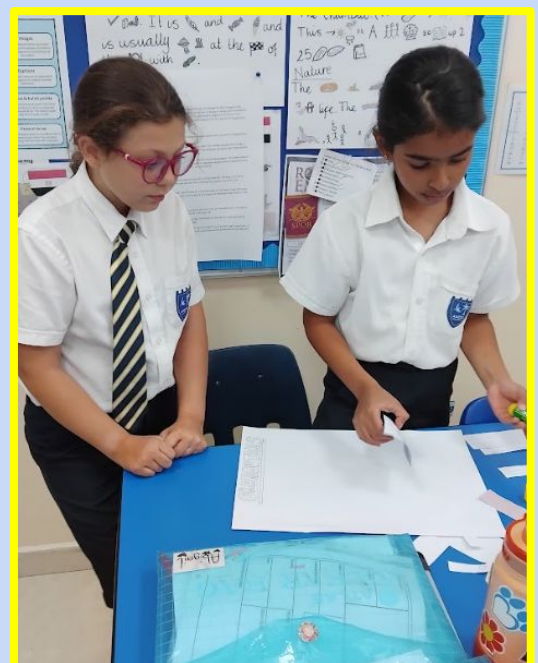
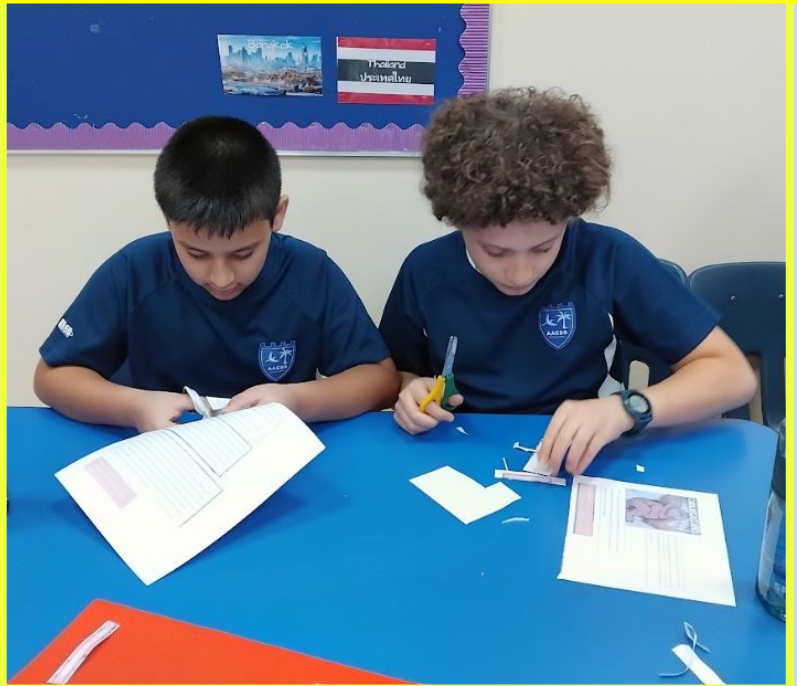
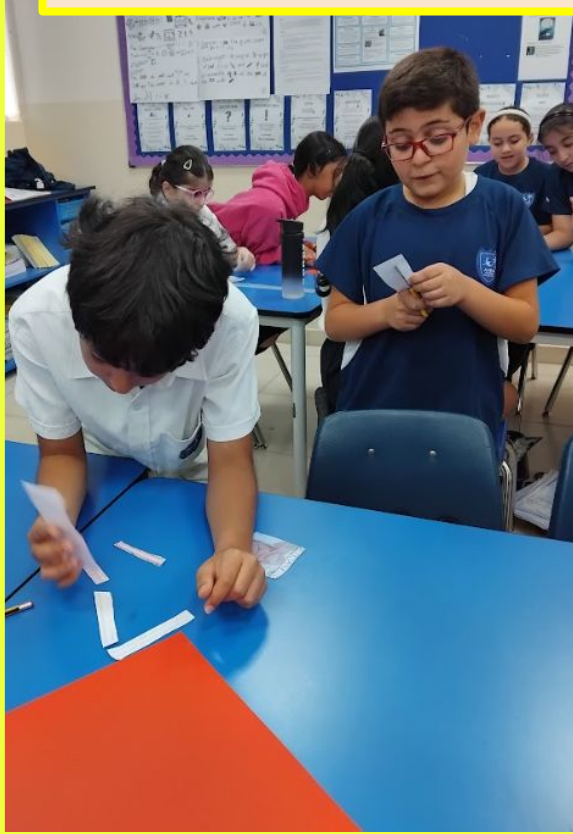
Inspired by the legacy of the founding father, Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, we will focus on the value of **Respect** in Term 3.
