Dear Parents,

Earlier this week you will have received the information about our Term 3 class teacher and parent meetings which are scheduled to be held **Monday 2nd June and Tuesday 3rd June.** The meetings will give you an opportunity to discuss the developments regarding your child's attainment and progress during this year.

Year 1 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 26th May

In maths we will revisit our place value topic and we will partition numbers into tens and ones using both practical equipment and written methods. We will then reinforce our knowledge of using a number line and identifying where different numbers belong on this and explain our reasons for our thinking.

During our English lessons, we will continue our new text 'The journey'. We will begin the week by discussing the front cover and sharing our predictions based on this. We will then look at the main character in the book and analyse her actions and feelings at various points. We will end the week by labeling pictures from the book using adjectives to add description.

In our Phonic lessons we will be learning consonant blends 'sp'(as in spot), 'st' (as in stop), 'sm' (as in smell) and 'sn' (as in snail). We will use our knowledge to read and spell words containing these sounds as well as forming them correctly. We will practise reading real words and pseudo alien words.

For science, we will work scientifically by completing the *Elephant's Toothpaste* experiment as conducted by our very own scientists. We will continue to ask questions and explore different ways they can be answered.

To support our students with their reading choices, we would like to recommend some great books and authors each half term.




Reading regularly in Arabic doesn't just help you get better at the language; it helps you shine in all your subjects too!


