FS2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 2nd June

This week in literacy, we will continue to delve into the story of The Gingerbread Man and bring it to life through Drawing Club—combining storytelling, creativity, and writing skills.

This week in maths, we will be consolidating all of our previous learning. Our focus will be on key skills such as number bonds to five and ten, as well as understanding the composition of numbers.

This week we will learn and practise the reading and spelling of CVCC/CCVC words, such as **much** and **flat**. We will also work on recognition and recall of previously taught graphemes and reading and writing sentences. HFWs for this week: **your**, **here**, **saw**.

In our Understanding the World lessons, we are wrapping up our topic on the heritage of the UAE. The children have thoroughly enjoyed learning about what makes the UAE special, including the seven emirates and their leaders.

This week in Expressive Arts and design we will be reviewing and reflecting on our end-of-year performance of Jack and the Beanstalk. The children will have the opportunity to talk about their roles, share what they enjoyed, and discuss what they learnt throughout.

In PSED, we will reflect on our time in FS2. We will discuss and compare how we felt in the beginning of the year with how we feel now about our classroom, teachers and friends. We will share what we liked most and what we found a little bit challenging and we will begin to discuss our feelings about Year 1.
