Preschool learning:

Week beginning: Monday 2nd June

This week in math, we will focus on recognising the number 3 in our environment and solving simple math problems using everyday objects. We will explore real-world mathematical challenges with numbers up to 5, encouraging each other to find 3 toys in the classroom and identify which number represents 3 toys. Additionally, we will have fun activities like searching for hidden number 3 cards, matching quantities, and practicing the formation of the number 3 using various materials.

This week in Drawing, we will be reading the delightful story "Oi Frog," which will help us enhance our understanding of rhyming words. We will also work on our drawing skills, and using a fun app, we will bring our creations to life. Our vocabulary words for this activity will include "frog," "log," and "dog." We can't wait to see the imaginative drawings that we will create as we explore these fun concepts!

This week in Literacy, we will be focusing on the final part of our model text for "Jack and the Beanstalk." We will also continue exploring the five key concepts of print, with a particular emphasis on understanding that print has meaning and can serve different purposes. These activities will help us deepen our comprehension and appreciation of written language.

This week in Understanding the World, we will continue exploring the world map and the various countries our families come from. We will pay special attention to the different languages used to greet one another. This activity will help us appreciate the diversity of cultures represented in our classroom! We look forward to sharing and learning about each other's backgrounds and fostering a sense of global community.

This week in Expressive Art and Design, we will continue to explore various materials freely, as this has captured our interest over the past week. We will further develop our ideas by discovering different ways to join objects together. Additionally, we will focus on expressing our thoughts more clearly by using meaningful vocabulary related to our creative projects.

Things to remember: Please continue to send in to school any clean empty boxes, containers, egg cartons, bottles, tins etc so that we can continue to enhance our innovative and creative skills. Thank you.
