Year 1 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 2nd June

In maths we will revisit our place value topic and we will identify numbers that are one more and one less than any given number. We will then compare numbers within 10 i.e 54 and 55 and explain our reasonings. We will end the week by using this knowledge to compare any 2 numbers within 100.

During our English lessons, we will continue our text 'The journey'. We will begin the week by making predictions about the next part of the story. We will discuss what we already know about the story and use this to aid our thinking. We will then use a range of punctuation such as full stop, exclamation and question mark, showing our understanding of when each one is needed.

In our Phonic lessons we will be learning consonant blends 'shr' (as in shrimp), 'thr' (as in three), 'str' (as in straw) and 'nch' (as in bench). We will use our knowledge to read and spell words containing these sounds as well as forming them correctly. We will practise reading real words and pseudo alien words.

For science, we will work scientifically by completing an experiment understanding what happens to yeast when making bread. We will continue to ask questions and explore different ways they can be answered.


Reading for pleasure can help to improve student achievement in school. Research has shown that students who read at home do 'significantly better' across the curriculum than students who don't read.


To support our students with their reading choices, we would like to recommend some great books and authors each half term.






Reading regularly in Arabic doesn't just help you get better at the language; it helps you shine in all your subjects too!


