Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 2nd June

Maths	The children will explore 3D shapes practically, by making them with a range of construction materials. To finish the week we will be learning to count up and back in multiples of 50 and 100, and using this knowledge to solve problems.	
English	We will continue to innovate our class text 'Egyptian Cinderella' planning and writing up paragraph 3 and 4. The children will be focusing on the features of a narrative and checking they have used the success criteria (punctuation including speech, adjectives, checking it makes sense and editing mistakes).	
Science	We will be using this week to revise all about magnets, particularly revising about poles, contact and non contact forces, and which metals are magnetic and which are not. These will be the areas our next hot assessment focuses on.	
Integrated Curriculum	In topic the children will be learning about the different egyptian landscapes, with a focus also being on the River Nile, farming and trading.


Reading for pleasure can help to improve student achievement in school. Research has shown that students who read at home do 'significantly better' across the curriculum than students who don't read.


