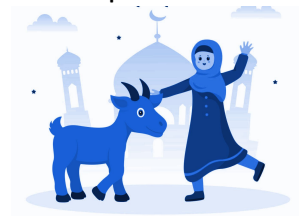
Dear Parents,

Year 4 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 2nd June

Maths	In Maths, Year 4 will be recapping decimals, including recognising them as fractions. They shall also be exploring adding and subtracting decimals through money.
English	In English, Year 4 will be beginning to write their own poem, based upon the model text 'The Sound Collector'. The children will be using the sounds they have collected the previous week.
Science	In Science, Year 4 will be exploring the time at which different shapes of ice melt under the sun. They will be experimenting to see if the shape of an item alters the given time to melt and then questioning why this happens.
Integrated Curriculum	In Topic, Year 4 will be developing their understanding about the Victorians. They will be exploring what the day in the life of a Victorian child really entailed.

Reading for Pleasure

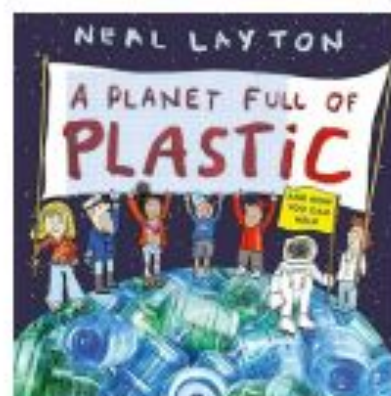
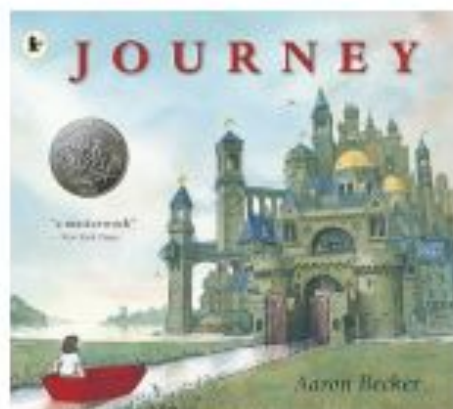
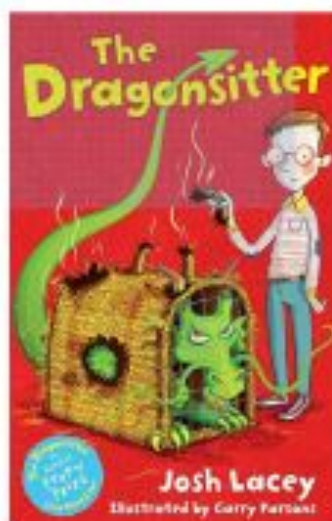

Did you know that reading in Arabic can take you on amazing adventures, introduce you to unforgettable characters, and help you fall in love with the language?

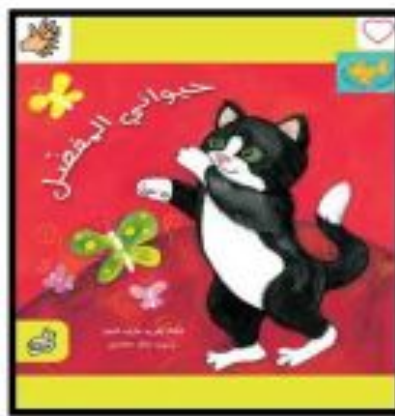

Empathy

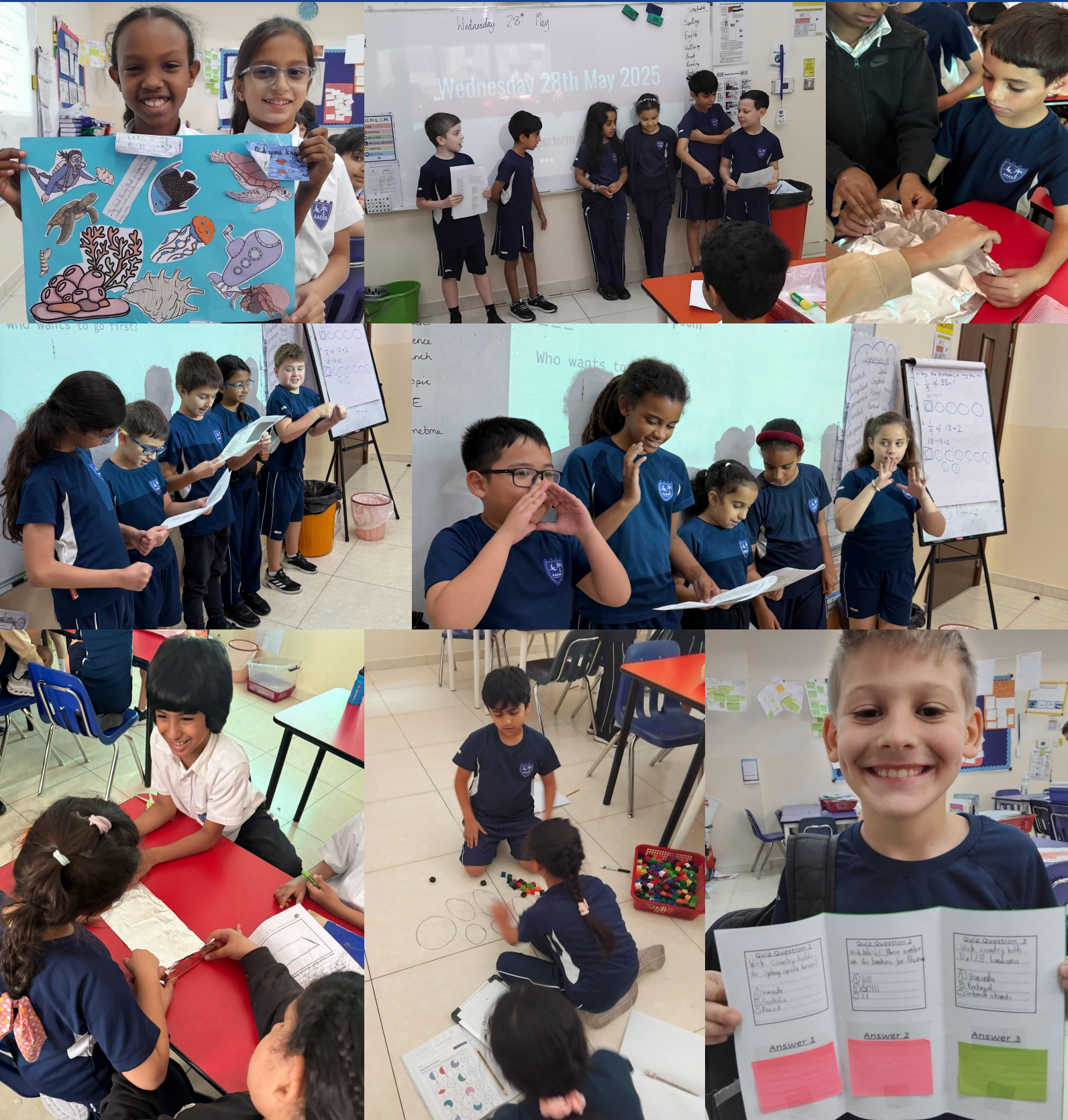


Inspired by the legacy of the founding father, Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, we will focus on the value of **Empathy** in Term 3.
