Year 5 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 2nd June

Maths	In Maths, the children will be looking at reflection and lines of symmetry. They will also be learning about volume and recapping their learning of cubes numbers.
English	We will be starting a new topic this week in Writing. The children will be looking at poetry. They will explore and read different types of poetry, learn the different features of poetry and the structure of poems.
Science	Continuing our learning of life cycles, the children will have the opportunity to observe real life egg shells, and eggs in an incubator. They will also be able to learn about the hatching of the chicks we had in school. In their second lesson, they will be learning about the life cycle of a mammal.
Integrated Curriculum	As we go into our second week of our new topic, the children will be learning about different migration routes of animals across the world.

To support our students with their reading choices, we would like to recommend some great books and authors each half term.





Each term, we'll share a list of exciting Arabic books and awesome authors for you to explore.








Inspired by the legacy of the founding father, Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, we will focus on the value of **Empathy** in Term 3.


Our expectations are that students will:

- Develop the capacity to forgive ourselves and others







