#### Week beginning: Monday 2nd June

Maths	In Maths, we will finish revising fractions by focusing on dividing them, then begin multiplying and dividing decimals by integers to build confidence with key skills.


Reading for pleasure can help to improve student achievement in school. Research has shown that students who read at home do 'significantly better' across the curriculum than students who don't read.


To support our students with their reading choices, we would like to recommend some great books and authors each half term.


