FS2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 22nd September 2025

In Understanding the World, we will be learning about the parts of a plant over the next two weeks. You are welcome to send flowers, leaves, or small plants to school for the children to observe, discuss, and use during discovery time.

This week in Maths, we will be focusing on matching and sorting. We will be exploring matching objects by colour, shape, and size as well as sorting items into categories (e.g., animals, vehicles, fruits) while using language like "same," "different," "group," and "sort". These activities support early maths skills and logical thinking.

In Personal, Social and Emotional Development, we will focus on building constructive and respectful relationships. We will talk about how we are all the same in some ways, but different in other ways and we need to be kind and respectful about this. In Physical Development, our focus will be on lining up at transition time and queuing and behaviour at mealtimes.

In Expressive Arts and Design, the children will explore the concept of family. They will learn to represent their own family using drawings and will design a house using craft materials. Children will be encouraged to reflect on what makes their family special and different.

This week in **Communication and Language**, we will continue to reinforce our key school rules and the importance of following different routine instructions in the classroom and around the school building to keep us safe and help us learn. In **Literacy**, we will be reading a new story called 'The Adventure in Al Ain'. The pupils will be encouraged to explore the props used to retell the story and help to develop their imagination and curiosity. The pupils will also be drawing their favourite character from the story in Drawing Club.

This week in **Phonics**, we will be learning about the new graphemes: 'm', 'd' and "g'. We will also recap the graphemes that we have covered over the last two-weeks: 's', 'a', 't', 'p' 'i' and 'n' using Monster Phonics. We will spend more time this week practicing blending and segmenting.
