Dear Parents,

Year 1 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 22nd September 2025

This week, we will continue with our text 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers and will be 'talking the text' using actions that we have created together. We will then identify the different characters and setting from the text. We will use this information to act the story out using props and puppet. We will end the week by sequencing the events in the correct order.

In maths, we will continue with our numbers 0-20. We will use our knowledge from last week to order numbers. Then we will learn how to add numbers using a number line. We will end the week learning how to use part whole models to help us make totals.

In phonics, we will work with the digraphs 'oi', 'ay' and 'oy'. We will be learning to identify, form and read words using these digraphs, as well as challenging ourselves to write them in words and sentences.

In science we will be learning about our 5 senses with a focus on the sense of touch. We will use our touch to identify different objects and textures.
