## Year 2 Learning:

**Week beginning: Monday 22nd September 2025**

<b>Maths</b>	In maths, we are continuing to learn about 'Place Value'. The children will need to identify and locate numbers on a number line, focusing first on the multiple of tens and then on any 2-digit number. They will then compare and order objects and numbers from 0 to 100 using concrete resources and pictorial representations.
<b>English</b>	In English, we are continuing to learn the story of 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'. The children will start the week by writing sentences independently, making sure that they are using capital letters and full stops correctly. Following this, they will work in groups to retell the story of 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch' using a story map and puppets.
<b>Science</b>	In science, the children will become scientists as they make predictions and record data when carrying out an experiment using eggs and vinegar.
<b>Integrated Curriculum</b>	In topic, the children will learn to understand the value of respecting ourselves and each other and will be introduced to some special characters to support with this. In art, the children will choose a hero from a selection of pictures before tracing the outline and planning what patterns and colours they will use to prepare for next week's lesson.

## Upcoming Events:

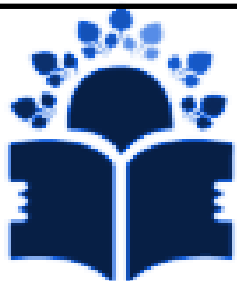
We will once again this year be recognising the Cognita Global Be Well Day with our students on Friday 26th September.
