FS2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 29th September 2025

In Personal, Social and Emotional Development, we will continue to Build constructive and respectful relationships. As well as Express their feelings and consider the feelings of others, working towards the understanding that we wall have different needs.

This week in Communication and Language, we will be extending our range of different social phrases that we can use when greeting our teachers and friends in class. We will also be going on a vocabulary treasure hunt to find words, pictures or objects from our story. In Literacy, we will continue to read 'The Adventure in Al Ain'. The pupils will be encouraged to explore the props used to retell the story and help to develop their imagination and curiosity. The pupils will also be drawing different settings from the story in Drawing Club. In Phonics, we will be learning about the new graphemes: 'o', 'c', 'k' and 'ck'. We will also recap the graphemes that we have covered over the last three weeks: 's', 'a', 't', 'p' 'i', 'n', 'm' 'd' and 'g' using Monster Phonics. Please follow this link when supporting your child to use the pure sounds: FS2 Pure Speech sounds

This week in maths, we will be looking at patterns. Children will be encouraged to notice and talk about patterns they see around and through playful activities, they will recognise simple repeating patterns (like red-blue-red-blue) and creating their own patterns using colours, shapes, sounds, and movements.

In our Understanding the World lessons we will continue to learn about the parts of a plant. The children are very excited with the idea of planting their own seeds at home. Click on the following link for easy instructions on how to plant your own seeds at home: <u>How to plant a seed.</u>

In Expressive Arts and Design, we will be creating collaboratively, sharing ideas, resources and skills. We will introduce the children to the artist Vincent van Gogh and support them in exploring a range of creative techniques inspired by his painting *Sunflowers*
