Year 2 Learning:

Week beginning: Monday 29th September 2025

Maths	In maths, we are continuing to learn about 'Place Value'. The children will begin the week by comparing and ordering objects and numbers from 0 to 100 using concrete resources and pictorial representations. They will also practise counting in 2s and 10s and identify multiples of 10s, using a variety of equipment, such as bead strings, dienes and hundred squares to support them.
English	This week, the children will start to plan and innovate the story of 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'. They will use their imagination to change parts of the story and then use their plan to begin writing the opening and the build-up to their version of the story. The children will continue to develop their independent writing skills by making sure that sentences are punctuated correctly and include adjectives.
Science	In science, the children will learn about how animals and humans have offspring which grow into adults.
Integrated Curriculum	In topic, the children will continue to learn about the lives of significant people. This week, they will focus on the lives of both Neil Armstrong and Florence Nightingale.

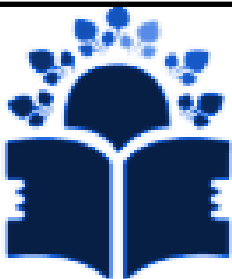
