Year 2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 6th October 2025

Maths	In maths, the children will begin learning about 'Addition and Subtraction'. They will first complete a cold task to identify their strengths and areas for development in this unit. The children will then move onto looking at number bonds to and within 10 in detail. They will first use concrete objects such as counters, cubes, ten frames and even fingers to make different number bonds and then learn to use the systematic approach to find all the bonds for a number to and within 10.
English	In English, the children will write the remaining sections of their innovated story, which is inspired by 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'. They will continue to talk the text for their own story and develop their independent writing skills by making sure that sentences are punctuated correctly and include adjectives. We will also encourage the children to edit and improve their work using a purple pen.
Science	In science, the children will learn about how animals and humans have offspring which grow into adults, with a focus on life cycles. When learning about the human life cycle, they will use vocabulary, such as baby, toddler, child, teenager and adult.
Integrated Curriculum	<p>Our 'Hero Dress Up Day' is on Friday (10th October). For inspiration, some of the heroes that we have been learning about in class include doctors, fire firefighters, police officers, scientists, astronauts, superheroes and Sheikh Zayed. We would also love the children to prepare a short presentation explaining who their hero is and why they have chosen that person as their hero.</p> <p>In art, the children will create their own hero themed, Roy Lichtenstein inspired 'Pop Art' artwork using pastels.</p>

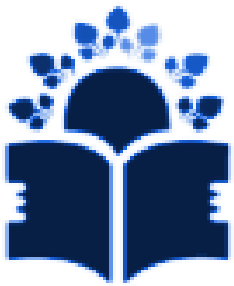

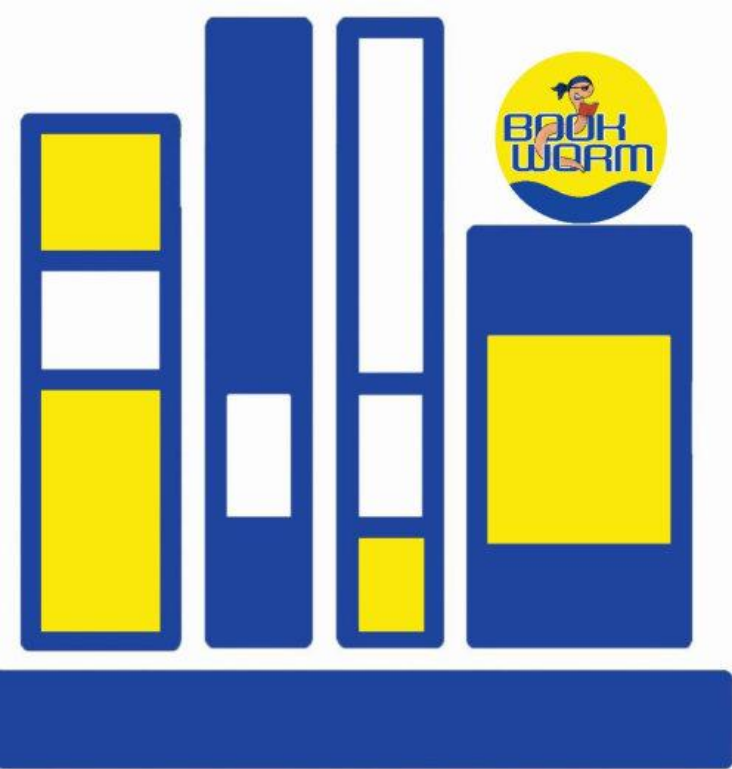
