Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 6th October 2025

English	In English, the children will be applying everything they've learned this half term to create their own story inspired by <i>The Greenship</i> . They will work more independently to plan and write their story, which will be used for assessment. As they write, they'll be encouraged to follow a set of success criteria, including the use of punctuation, adjectives, expanded noun phrases, and prepositions.
Maths	In Maths, we will continue our work on addition and subtraction. This will include adding two numbers across 100, subtracting across 10, adding a 3-digit and a 2-digit number, and subtracting a 2-digit number from a 3-digit number. We will also consolidate our understanding of the column method. To finish the half term, the children will complete a hot assessment covering both place value and the addition and subtraction unit.
Science	To conclude this half terms topic on plants, the children will be learning how different plants adapt to the climates and environments they live in. We will be focusing on the UAE national flower, its importance and how it survives in difficult conditions. To end the half term the children will complete a hot assessment on the plants topic.
Topic	As we continue our food technology unit, the children will make their sandwiches using the method they wrote last week. While eating their sandwiches, they will evaluate them against a set of success criteria and consider ways they could improve their design. Finally, they will redesign their sandwiches and create an advert to promote them. This could be in the form of a poster or a verbal presentation.

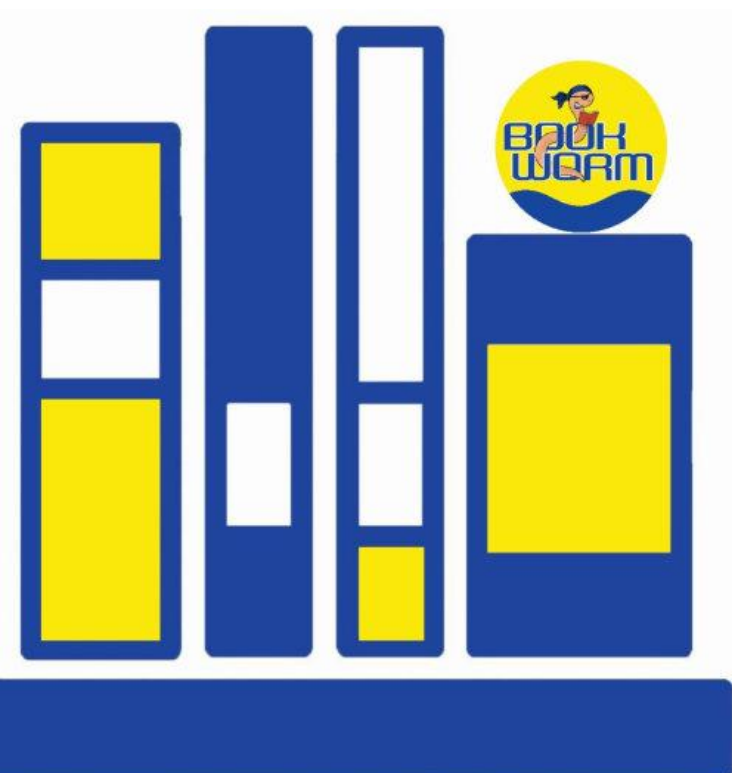

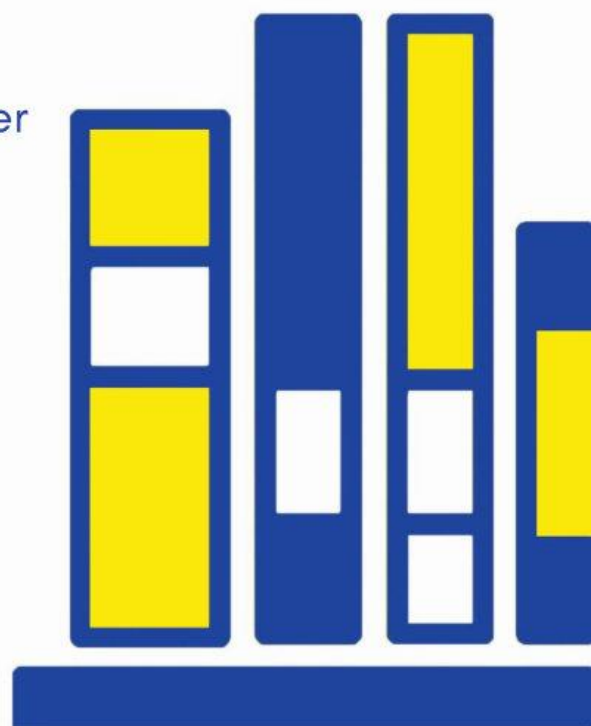
