Year 4 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 6th October 2025

English	In English, the children will be finishing their work for their story openers by inventing their own story and characters. They will be using their writing toolkit when completing this, with a focus on fronted adverbials, capital letters, full stops, commas and descriptive adjectives for characters and settings.
Maths	In Maths, the children will continue to expand their understanding of addition by using the column method to add without exchanges and with 1 exchange. They will then move on to subtraction in the column method with no exchanges. As well as this, they will be consolidating their understanding of the entirety of the term.
Science	In Science, the children will be consolidating their learning about living things and their habitats. This will be an accumulation of their learning from the entire term.
Topic	In Topic, the children will be designing and building their own sustainable city. Within previous lessons the children have looked at how to be sustainable and will now be putting this into practice when they create their own.

Year 4 Sustainably City Building

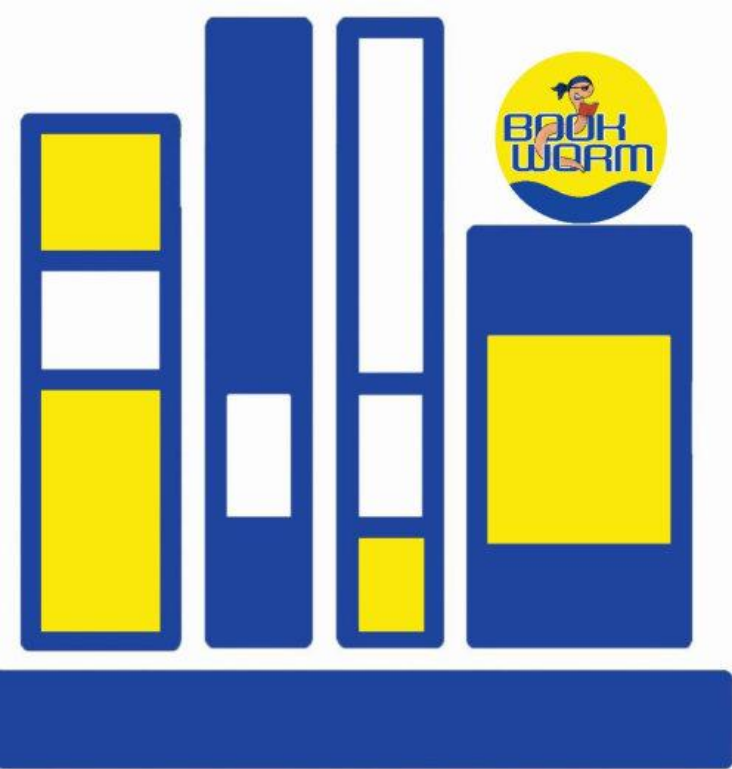
