Week beginning: Monday 6th October 2025		
Maths	Next week, the children will be moving onto subtraction. They will be subtracting with 4 and 5 digit numbers with exchanges, solving word problems with subtracting and using the inverse. After this, the children will consolidate their learning of place value from this term.	
Writing	Now the children have had a go at innovating our model text of a newspaper report, the children will be using everything they have learnt this half term, to plan and write their own newspaper report that should include: a headline, an introduction with the 4W's, direct and Indirect speech, past tense verbs, a caption and fronted adverbials.	
Integrated curriculum	The children have a very exciting week in our integrated curriculum lessons next week. After practicing and writing a script for a podcast about the UAE, the children will head down to the media suite and collaborate to create their very own podcast!	
Science	Next week, the children will be consolidating their learning from this term and will have a chance to reflect on their understanding.


