Year 1 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 20th October 2025

This week, we will begin our new talk for writing text topic and start learning about instructions. We will begin the week by verbally following everyday instructions and then following a set of given instructions to make an item. Toward the end of the week, we will focus on the features of an instructional text such as a title.

In maths, we will begin our topic on measurement and start by looking at length and height. We will begin the week by learning the vocabulary related to this topic and rehearse using this when practically measuring. Throughout the week we will then measure the length and height of everyday objects using non-standard and standard units.

In phonics, we will learn our split digraphs, u-e as in tube (U - Hoo), u-e as in June (Cool Blue) and ar as in jar. We will be learning to identify, form and read words using these, as well as challenging ourselves to write the split digraphs in words and sentences.

In science we will be begin our work about materials. We will start by identifying the materials of everyday objects such as paper, wood, metal. We will then group different objects that are made from the same material.
