Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 13th October 2025

English	Our next topic is all about advertisements. This week, we'll learn new vocabulary from our next text, "Welcome to Al Ain Zoo." We'll explore how alliteration can make writing more engaging and practice using it in our own work. We'll also examine different adverts to discover the persuasive language and features they use.
Maths	in Maths, the children will be developing their understanding of addition and subtraction with 3-digit numbers. They will begin by adding 3-digit and 2-digit numbers without exchanging, before moving on to adding 3-digit and 3-digit numbers where exchanging is needed. The children will then apply their knowledge to subtraction, learning how to exchange tens and hundreds when subtracting 3-digit numbers. They will use practical resources and column methods to show their working clearly and explain their reasoning.
Science	In Science we will be continuing our topic on Plants and learning about the life cycle of a plant. The children will be learning the names and what happens in each stage. Starting with germination, then growing, pollination, fertilization and seed formation and seed dispersal.
Topic	Our new topic, " Oasis in the Desert ," is a local study focusing on Al Ain, exploring its past and present. The children will begin by locating Al Ain on a world map, followed by identifying its position within the UAE and the emirates. They will watch a video to learn what an oasis is and understand its significance. In Art, the children will explore how to draw an oasis, with a focus on developing their understanding of tone.
