FS2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 27th October 2025

In Understanding the World this week, we will learn about different houses and homes around the world. We will explore how the weather and environment can affect the way houses are built, and discuss how durable they are. Together, we'll look at the similarities and differences between homes and the materials used to build them.

In Communication and Language, we will be learning to develop and extend our expressive communication by incorporating Makaton Signs into our daily routines and in our play. We will also be learning the Sign of the Week in English, Arabic and in Makaton.

In PSED we will be discussing how every child is a valuable individual in our classrooms. We will work on building confidence and focus on speaking clearly in front of an audience. We will celebrate our differences and discuss what we can do when we find things a bit tricky. In PD we will continue to develop our fluent movements in preparation for our Talk 4 Writing poem.

In Maths, we will be exploring number composition—how numbers from 1 to 5 can be made by combining smaller numbers. We will be discovering how a 2 can be made from 1 and 1 and 3 can be made from 2 and 1, etc.

In Phonics, we will be focusing on the new graphemes and diagraphs "f", "ff", "l", "ll' and 'ss' using Monster Phonics. We will also be consolidating all of the sounds that we have covered so far to ensure that.

In Literacy this week, we will be continuing our new story, "The Three Little Hamsters." We'll be exploring the story together and learning lots of new vocabulary to help us understand and talk about the characters, setting, and events.

In Expressive Arts and Design, we will be building with purpose. First, we will plan our ideas on paper, then use our design to guide our building process. Kindly send in recycled materials such as tissue boxes, shoe boxes, or pieces of cardboard.


