## Year 1 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 27th October 2025

This week, we will continue with our work on instructions. We will recap the features of instructions and understand what each part tells us. We will then receive a letter from Ms Catrin and use our knowledge of instruction to help create a set as a class. We will end the week by sequencing the instructions and adding actions to them to aid our talk for writing.

In maths, we will continue with our topic of measure. We will learn about mass and capacity and start by understanding and using the vocabulary associated with these. We will then measure the weight and capacity of various objects using standard and non-standard units.

In phonics, we will learn our digraphs, ee as in green, ea as in leaf and er as in her. We will be learning to identify, form and read words using these, as well as challenging ourselves to write the sounds in words and sentences.

In science we will be learning more about materials and will explore the difference between the object and the material it is made from.
