# Year 2 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 27th October 2025

Maths	In maths, the children are continuing to develop their addition and subtraction skills. They will begin the week by learning to add a one-digit number to a two-digit number and subtract a one-digit number from a two-digit number. Next, we will practise doubling numbers up to 10. We will encourage the children to identify patterns before recalling these number facts and applying them to problem solving tasks. Finally, the children will learn to add three 1-digit numbers. They will be shown how to use different strategies, such as doubles and number bonds to help them work out the answers. They will also use practical equipment, such as dienes, bead strings, number lines and tens frames to support their learning.
English	In English, the children will begin to practise orally retelling the Worry Monster's letter. After that, they will be working collaboratively to deepen their understanding of the key vocabulary from the model text. The children will then learn about and identify the features of the Worry Monster's letter. For example: the greeting, an opening statement, the main text, a closing statement, the ending, sentences with conjunctions ('and', 'so' or 'but), question sentences, exclamation sentences and past tense verbs. They will finish the week by learning about how and when to use question marks.
Science	In science, the children will continue to investigate 'Living Things and their Habitats' by identifying and naming a variety of local plants and animals and describing their habitats.
Integrated Curriculum	In Integrated Curriculum lessons, the children will become explorers as they use atlases to locate and name the world's continents. We will also discuss the world's oceans.  In Art, we have been looking at 'landscape artwork' from four different artists. This week, we will have the opportunity to sketch a mountain landscape.
