FS2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 10th November 2025

This week in Literacy, we will continue building on our story in Drawing Club and we will have a big focus on writing words using our phonic knowledge.

In Communication and Language, we will continue to develop and extend our expressive communication by incorporating Makaton Signs into our daily routines and in our play. The Sign of the Week is "angry", we will learn this in English, Arabic and in Makaton.

In PSED, we will work on reciting our Talk for Writing poems with confidence. We will also focus on big, controlled movements during our Winter show songs.

In Phonics, we will be revising Term 1 tricky words (I, go, no, to, into and the) and practicing blending and segmenting. We will also continue to recap all the graphemes and diagraphs that we have covered so far.

In Expressive Arts and Design, the children will continue working on their own mini Al Ain, creating their allocated buildings. They will learn and apply different joining techniques and think carefully about how to build with purpose and creativity.

This week in Understanding the World, we will be recapping buildings, building materials, and how weather can affect the way we build houses.

This week in maths, we will be exploring the concept of "one more" and "one less" using numbers up to 5. Through playful stories, hands-on activities, and outdoor games, they'll learn to identify what comes before and after a given number. We'll be using number lines, and visual prompts to make these ideas fun. You can support this learning at home by asking questions like, "What is one more than 2?" or "What is one less than 4?"—and encouraging your child to use fingers, toys, or drawings to show their thinking.

everything.


