## Year 2 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 10th November 2025

Maths	In maths, the children will develop their counting skills with a focus on counting in 2s and 5s from any given number. For example, they could practise counting in 2s starting at the number 12 or counting in 5s starting from 25. The children will also practise counting back in 2s and 5s from any given number. They will use 100 squares and counters to help support their learning.
English	In English, the children will continue to practise retelling the letter from The Worry Monster. Following this, they will discuss what happened during their special 'What a Wonderful World' Day. They will share their thoughts and feelings about it before beginning to plan and write their own letter about the day. In their letter, they should include conjunctions (and, but and so), past tense verbs, exclamation sentences and question sentences.
Science	In science, the children will continue to learn about the unit 'Living Things and their Habitats' by deepening their understanding of how animals obtain their food.
Integrated Curriculum	On Monday 10th November, the children will take part in a special learning day linked to our topic for this half term. During the day, they will learn about the seven continents and enjoy a range of fun and memorable activities related to each one.  Please allow your child to wear non-uniform on this day. They should wear comfortable clothes and shoes suitable for active learning.
