Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 10th November 2025

English	This week we will begin our innovate stage of planning our own persuasive advert on Al Ain Zoo. The children will begin to plan and write up paragraphs 1 and 2 using a set of success criteria. We will be encouraging the use of appealing adjectives, rhetorical questions, alliterations, exaggeration and boastful language throughout the writing journey.
Maths	We will continue our multiplication and division unit this week, focusing on the 3, 4 and 10 times table. The children will begin by using related facts to multiply and to multiply and divide by 3 and 4.
Science	We will continue our pollination investigation this week by first making observations of how pollination occurs in different plants. After discussing our observations and recording what we notice, we will write up our results carefully, analyzing what our findings show about the process of pollination. Finally, we will draw conclusions based on our observations and discuss what we have learned about the important role pollinators play in plant reproduction.
Topic	This week's learning will focus on the discovery of oil and its significant impact on the development of the United Arab Emirates (UAE). We will explore how the discovery of oil transformed the nation's economy, society, and infrastructure, turning it from a region dependent on fishing and pearl diving into one of the most prosperous and modern countries in the world. In ART, the children will be exploring how to use wax crayons to draw desert cacti.
