- Understand and support each other if mistakes are made

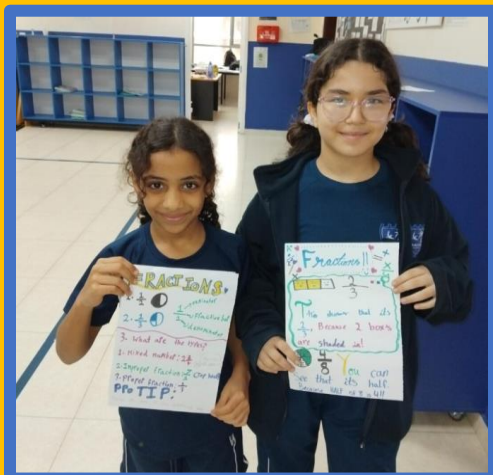
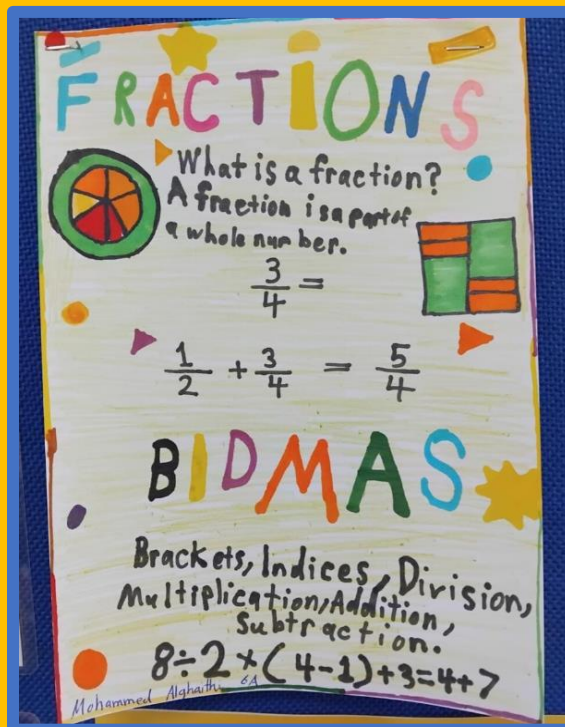
