## FS2 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 17th November 2025

In Communication and Language, we will continue to develop and extend our expressive communication by incorporating Makaton signs into our daily routines and play.

The sign of the Week is "worried". We will learn this in English, Arabic, and in Makaton.

In PSED, we will continue to focus on ourselves as valuable individuals. We are still working hard to finalise our sharing morning as well as our winter show performances.

In Phonics, we will be learning our new graphemes from Phase 3 of Monster Phonics: 'j', 'v', 'w', and 'x'. We will also continue to revise and consolidate our prior learning by recapping all the sounds from Phase 2 and the Tricky Words from Term 1.

In anticipation of National Day, we will begin learning about what makes the UAE special, the seven emirates, the leaders of the country, and its rich heritage in Understanding the World. We will also be exploring a variety of National Day activities in Expressive Arts and Design.

In Maths, we will be working with numbers from 1 to 5 and practising how to look at two groups of objects and decide which has more, which has fewer, or whether they are the same. This helps children build confidence with counting and prepares them for addition and subtraction later.

This week in Literacy, we will be rehearsing our story of "The Three Little Hamsters" and innovating our story to create our own exciting version.


