Year 2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 17th November 2025

Maths	In maths, the children will begin to learn about money. They will start the week by investigating dirhams and fils. The children will then focus on counting money, using only notes at first and then moving onto using notes and coins. When counting money, the children will use their knowledge of counting in 2s, 5s and 10s to find the total, before moving onto counting different amounts of money up to the value of 100AED. Following this, they will choose an amount of money. This will involve selecting notes from a bigger set, reinforcing their learning of counting money as a method for checking their answers.
English	In English, the children will continue to plan and write a letter about our 'What a Wonderful World' Day last week. The children will be expected to include the following features: past tense verbs, conjunctions ('and', 'but' and 'so') and different punctuation (such as full stops, question marks and exclamation marks).
Science	In science, the children will be learning about microhabitats. Within the lesson, they will have a nature walk around the school and investigate which minibeasts live in different microhabitats.
Integrated Curriculum	In Integrated Curriculum, the children will look at different landmarks from around the world and discuss what features they have. They will then learn which of these features are considered human features (man-made) and which are physical features (natural).
