Maths	In Maths, we will be recapping our understanding of multiplication and division by solving word problems. Then, we will be learning about square and cube numbers.
Writing	As we continue our learning of writing myths, the children will be using what they have learnt so far to innovate our model text of Theseus and the Minotaur.
Integrated curriculum	In topic, the children will continue their learning of the Romans by learning about the Roman towns and the Roman army.
Science	The children will be using the evidence from their last investigation to write a scientific report. Then, they will be learning about thermal conductors and insulators.

Our expectations are that students will:


- Show respect for the thoughts and opinions of others
