Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 24th November 2025

English	This week in English the children will begin the 'invent' stage of Talk For Writing where they will be independently planning and writing their own advert on a different attraction in the UAE. The children will be encouraged to use the skills they have learnt about what makes a good advert to write their own.
Maths	To start off the week, we will be revising addition, subtraction, measurement and multiplication and division. Then the children will sit the hot assessment to see what they have learnt and which areas we need to revisit. We will then begin our 'Statistics' unit, where we will explore interpreting pictograms and bar charts and drawing our own.
Science	This week we will be revising the life cycle of a plant, pollination and seed dispersal ready for our hot assessment later in the week.
Topic	This week's focus will be on agriculture in the UAE and in particular farming. If your child lives on a farm or you have a family farm, please bring in any photos of your farm/ animals to share with the class. In art we will explore local UAE artists like Abdul Qadar Al Rais and create art Islamic artwork in this style.
