English	In English, Year 4 will be re-exploring creative writing, specifically setting descriptions and using technical devices such as similes and metaphors to improve their descriptions. They will be using their knowledge of these devices to plan and write.
Maths	In Maths, Year 4 will be consolidating their learning from the entire term. They will be exploring what they have already learnt and using this to answer worded questions. Also, they will be recapping previous learning around addition and subtraction.
Science	In Science, Year 4 will be completing their learning on animals and consolidating their understanding of what they have learnt this term. They will finalise their understanding of this topic by answering worded questions.
Topic	In Topic, Year 4 will be building their bridges as a final step to completing the topic for the half term. They have previously been designing and testing materials which they would like to use. This week they will be working with their group to create their design.
