Week beginning: Monday 24th November 2025

Maths	Next week, the children will recap their learning from the term, which includes: multiplication, division, addition, subtraction and rounding numbers. They will then complete the end of unit assessment.
Writing	The children will be using everything they have learnt from this half term to plan and write their very own myth. They will need to include descriptive language, fronted adverbials, paragraphs to group ideas and powerful verbs and adverbs to describe action.

Science	Next week, the children will bring all their learning together to complete an end of unit assessment for this half term. They will then reflect on their learning.


For the last 2 weeks, Year 5 have been down to the stem building to design and bake their own bread. Well done year 5!
