Preschool learning:

Week beginning: Monday 1st December 2025

This week in Phonics, we will enjoy all the different sounds and rhythms we have learned so far, from environmental and instrumental sounds to body percussion and rhyme. We will have lots of fun using these skills through playful and engaging activities ready for moving forward onto our new aspect after the Winter break.

This week in Literacy, we will explore a selection of storybooks alongside the instruction cards from our previous activities, such as making giant bubbles, slime, and walking water. We will help each other to sort and recognise the difference between a story and an instruction, then attempt to recall one of the key steps from the instruction cards.

This week in Math we will be reviewing counting and matching the right number of objects to the correct numeral. We will practise counting small sets of objects and say how many we counted in total. The children will have more opportunities to review subitising by looking at amounts of objects up to 2 and saying how many they see.

This week in Expressive Art and Design we will be diving into winter fun! We will whip up magical puffy paint by mixing shaving foam and white paint to make our very own snowman. Then, we will get creative by choosing colorful buttons, scarves, hats, and more to bring our frosty friend to life!

This week in Understanding the World, we will be exploring and reviewing the concept of life cycles, focusing on both plants and butterflies. We will revisit how a tiny seed grows into a flowering plant and how a caterpillar transforms into a butterfly, making connections between the two processes. Through videos, sequencing activities, and movement-based role play, we will have opportunities to recall the stages, use key vocabulary such as seed, sprout, flower, caterpillar, chrysalis, butterfly, and demonstrate our understanding in creative ways.

Things to remember: Friday 5th December will be the last day of term 1. Please can you return your child's plastic folder to your class teacher if you have not done so already. Thank you for your support.
