Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 1st December 2025

English	In the final week of term, the children will use the plans they created last week to produce their final 'hot write' an advert for an attraction of their choice. They will be encouraged to follow the success criteria, including the use of boastful language, rhetorical questions, alliteration, persuasive vocabulary, and appropriate punctuation.
Maths	Continuing our Statistics unit, the children will be developing their skills by learning how to draw clear and accurate bar graphs using given sets of data. They will explore how to label axes correctly, choose suitable scales, and present information neatly. In addition, they will be introduced to interpreting two-way tables, using them to compare different categories, answer questions and explain what it shows.
Science	Due to there being no school on Monday or Tuesday, there will be no science lessons this week.
Topic	The children will be learning about the significance of UAE National Day and why it is celebrated each year. They will explore the history of the union of the seven emirates, understanding how this important event marked the beginning of the United Arab Emirates as a nation. Through discussions, stories, and activities, the children will gain an appreciation of the country's heritage, its leaders, and the values that bring people together. This learning will help them develop a deeper sense of pride and understanding of the culture and traditions of the UAE.
