Year 4 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 1st December 2025

English	In English, the children will be consolidating their understanding of writing features, such as adjectives, similes, metaphors and subordinate clauses and conjunctions. They will also be using their learning to write a story.
Maths	In Maths, Year 4 will be cementing their learning from the entire term. They will be exploring previously taught aspects such as multiplication, addition and subtraction to ensure they have a solid base ready to continue into the subsequent term.
Science	In Science, Year 4 will be investigating and completing stem-style experiments. They will be doing this to practice their enquiry skills and how to conduct and write up an experiment fairly.
Topic	In Topic, the children will be thinking about the bridges they made this week. They will be evaluating what went well about their bridges and what they would change next time if they were to do it again.
