FS2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 27th October 2025

In Communication and Language this week we will be developing and extending our expressive communication by incorporating Makaton Signs into our daily routines and play. The Sign of the Week is "sad", which we will learn in English, Arabic, and Makaton.

We will continue to explore how we see ourselves as valuable individuals in PSED. The children will also think about how they can help their friends to be brave in tricky situations and to recognise their own worth. We are working hard on our poems in preparation for our Sharing Morning.

In Phonics we will be consolidating all the graphemes and digraphs we have covered so far this year using Monster Phonics: S, A, T, P, I, N, M, D, G, O, C, K, CK, E, U, R, H, B, F, FF, L, LL, and SS. We will also continue practising the tricky words from Term 1.

This week in Literacy, we will be learning to retell the story of The Three Little Hamsters using actions, focusing on the exciting chase and the strong brick house. The children will explore how the clever hamsters stay safe by building, hiding, and creating a trap for the sneaky cat. They will use new vocabulary such as clever, strong, and protect while drawing and writing about their own strong houses and clever traps.

In Expressive Arts and Design, the children will be working on their own mini Al Ain, creating their allocated buildings. They will learn and apply different joining techniques and think carefully about how to build with purpose and creativity.

This week in Understanding the World, we will be exploring buildings of the past and present, noticing differences and similarities, making comparisons, and discussing various building materials used over time.

In Maths, we will continue building our understanding of number composition using the part-whole model to explore numbers beyond 5. The children will begin creating simple addition stories using everyday objects and drawings, helping them connect number combinations to real-life situations.
