Maths		This week in maths, we will be solving problems with division as well as starting our new topic – fractions. To begin, we will recap our knowledge of fractions from Year 5 before exploring equivalent fractions and simplifying fractions.
Writing		This week, the children will be writing their HOT Task for English. It will be a persuasive letter. The expectations would be for children to ensure that they use all the features of persuasive letter writing taught over the last few weeks and an opportunity for them to showcase this learning.
IC		This week, we will be working in our teams to conduct in-depth research and gather detailed information about our assigned European country. Each team will explore different aspects such as geography, culture, history, economy, and key landmarks.
Science		This week in Science we will continue our new unit on Adaptation and Inheritance. We will be investigating how plants have adapted to living in their specific biomes. How have they adapted, and how are they suited to live there.
