Year 5 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 5th January 2026

Maths	In Maths, we will be moving our learning onto decimals. This week, the children will be adding and subtracting decimals, adding decimals to 1 and adding and subtracting across 1.
Writing	As we begin a new term, we will be starting our new writing genre. The children will be learning how to write instructions. This week, the children will be unpicking the new model text, before being introduced to modal verbs and organisational devices.
Integrated curriculum	The children will be introduced to our new topic for this half term – Extreme Survival. This week, we will introduce them to earthquakes and how earthquake drills work.
Science	In science, the children will be starting a new topic of forces. This week, the children will start by learning about friction and its effects before delving into an investigation to test friction of different objects.


