Parent Access Pass Information

Please be reminded that in line with updated policy requirements, parents or carers of children in Primary will need to wear their permanent access pass to enter the school site and drop off or collect their children.



Our school uniform is designed to be weather appropriate. Year 1 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 19th January 2026

This week, we will continue with our Meerkat Mail text during our Talk 4 Writing lessons. We will revisit the text daily and will use our own actions to it to help us remember the text. Then we will retell and sequence events in the story and identify them from the beginning, middle and end of the story. We will then edit the character from the story and change the setting to make our own version of the text.

In maths, we will complete our place value work and focus on numbers to 50. We shall understand how these are represented using tens and ones. We will start the week by using equipment to make the numbers then write this in numerals from a pictorial representation. We will end the week identifying numbers that are more and less.

In phonics, we will learn the digraphs igh (Yellow I) as in light, or as in for and ore as in sore. We will identify, read and write words using these sounds, as well as challenging ourselves to write simple sentences.

In Science, we will recap our learning about animals and the groups they belong to such as mammals, reptiles, birds, insects, fish and amphibians. We will then learn about herbivores, carnivores or omnivores and explore some of the animals that have each of these diets.




