| Maths | In maths, the children will continue their learning on fractions. This week, they will be learning to add and subtract fractions with the same denominator and add and subtract fractions with different denominators. They will also learn to add mixed numbers. |
| Writing | Now the children have planned their survival guide, they will be innovating the model text to write a set of instructions. They will need to include organisational devices learnt so far this term. |
| Integrated curriculum | In topic, the children will continue their collaborative work on researching a natural disaster. They will start to think about how they are going to put this into a presentation to share with the rest of the class. |
| Science | As the children continue their learning of forces, they will be learning to understand the benefits of levers. Then, in Ms Taylor's lesson, they will be conducting a fair test involving air resistance. |
