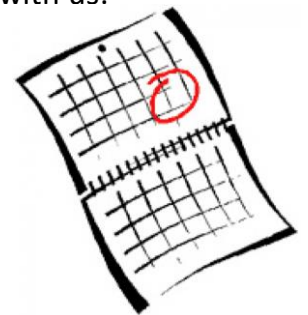
Dear Parents,

Preschool learning:

Week beginning: Monday 2nd February 2026

This week in literacy, we'll be finishing our story work and helping the children grow in confidence as they retell *The Bus Is for Us*. We'll create a Talk for Writing video for the children to watch and discuss.. Then we'll have some fun by exploring new ideas, changing the vehicle in the story, and practising the new lines with actions. This will support their sequencing skills, language development, and creativity.

This week in phonics, we will continue exploring alliteration and helping the children tune into words that start with the same sound. The children will enjoy listening to fun alliteration stories and joining in with repeated sound patterns. Through playful activities and shared reading, they'll begin to recognise how authors use the same initial sounds to make stories catchy and memorable.

This week in Maths we will continue to identify patterns in the environment, as well as make patterns of our own using different materials. We will go on a pattern hunt around the school to see how many different patterns we can find.

This week in Understanding the World we will revisit the five senses and explore the sense of taste by choosing one item from our lunchboxes to describe and discuss what we taste. We will use new vocabulary such as *sweet*, *sour*, *salty*, *spicy* while sharing our likes and dislikes in a fun and interactive way.

This week in Expressive Arts and Design, the children will explore different materials freely as they create their own transport models using recycled materials, inspired by the story *The Bus Is For Us*. We will develop their creativity, fine motor skills and confidence in sharing their ideas.
