Year 2 Learning:

Week beginning: Monday 2nd February 2026

Maths	The children will continue the unit <i>Statistics</i> . This week, they will practise creating and interpreting pictograms. They will need to look at the key to help them interpret the data correctly. For example, if 1 ball is equal to 2 goals, then how many goals did a player score if she has 3 balls?
English	In English, the children will continue to 'talk the text' of <i>Jack and the Beanstalk</i> . They will begin the week by developing their understanding of how sentences should be structured. Following this, the children will use pictures and their knowledge of the story to write their own sentences. They will be encouraged to say their sentence, write it and read it back (to check it makes sense) each time. Next, the children will start to plan their story by choosing an alternative character for Jack and write a character description to describe his/her appearance, personality and behaviour.
Science	In science, the children will continue to learn about <i>Plants</i> . This week, we will focus on how seeds are dispersed.
Integrated Curriculum	In Integrated Curriculum, the children will compare UAE forts and UK castles to each other, as they discuss their similarities and differences.

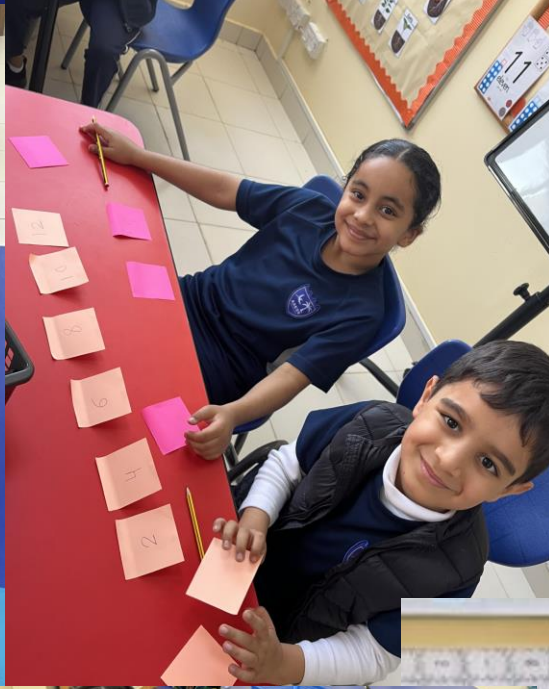
